

VL Summer School – 3 weeks, intensive program of academic study and specialized field trips, excursions and folk art master-classes is designed by two Universities in the different cities providing a truly life-changing experience to students from all over the world!

VL Summer School is a great way to boost up your academic knowledge during the summer holiday and immerse yourself in the culture and social life of the Russian Far East. You will understand the history, current state and development prospects of this region, its regional socio-economic situation and unique local nature. You also have a chance to participate in a range of exciting activities comprising exploration of the Southern Sikhote-Alin mountain-taiga and tiger habitat.

Language of the program is English. International students whose first language is not English are required to have at least Intermediate level to participate in VL Summer School.
